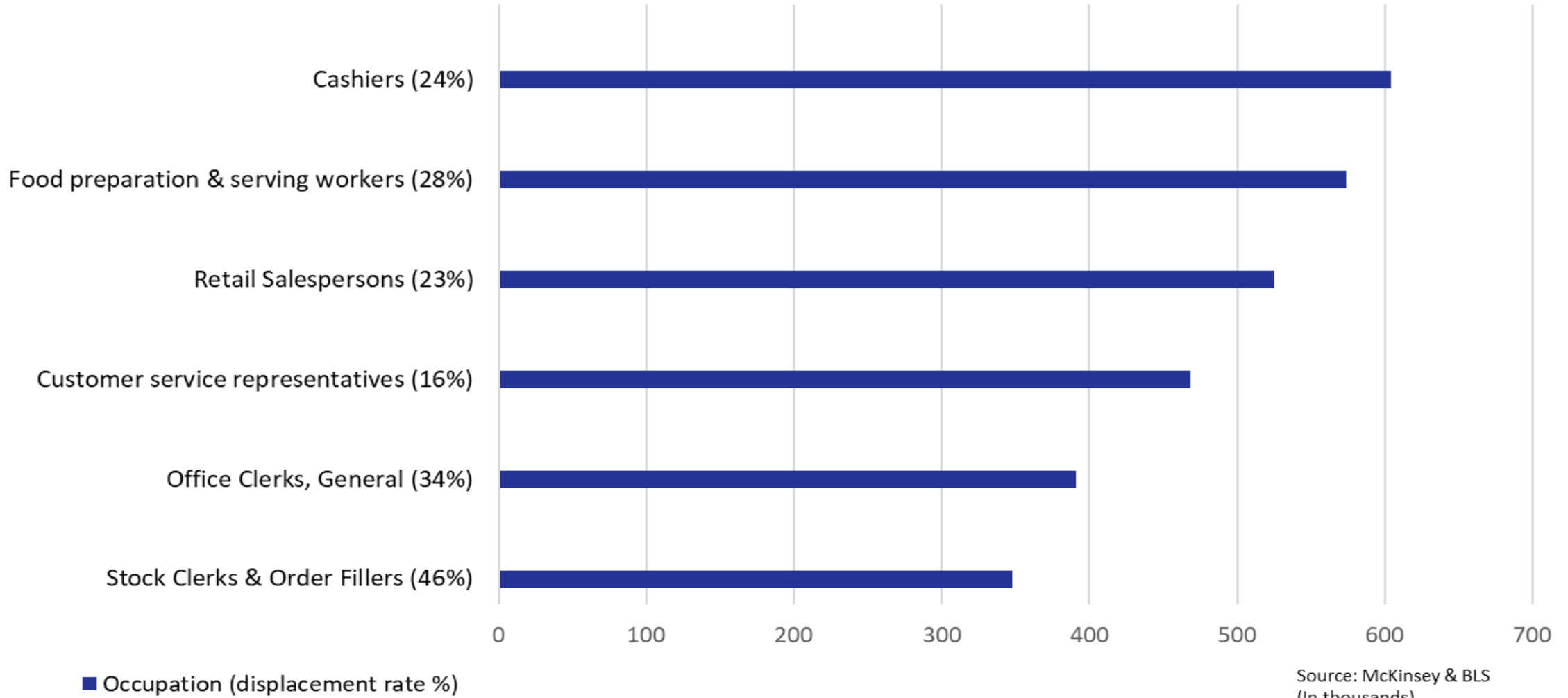

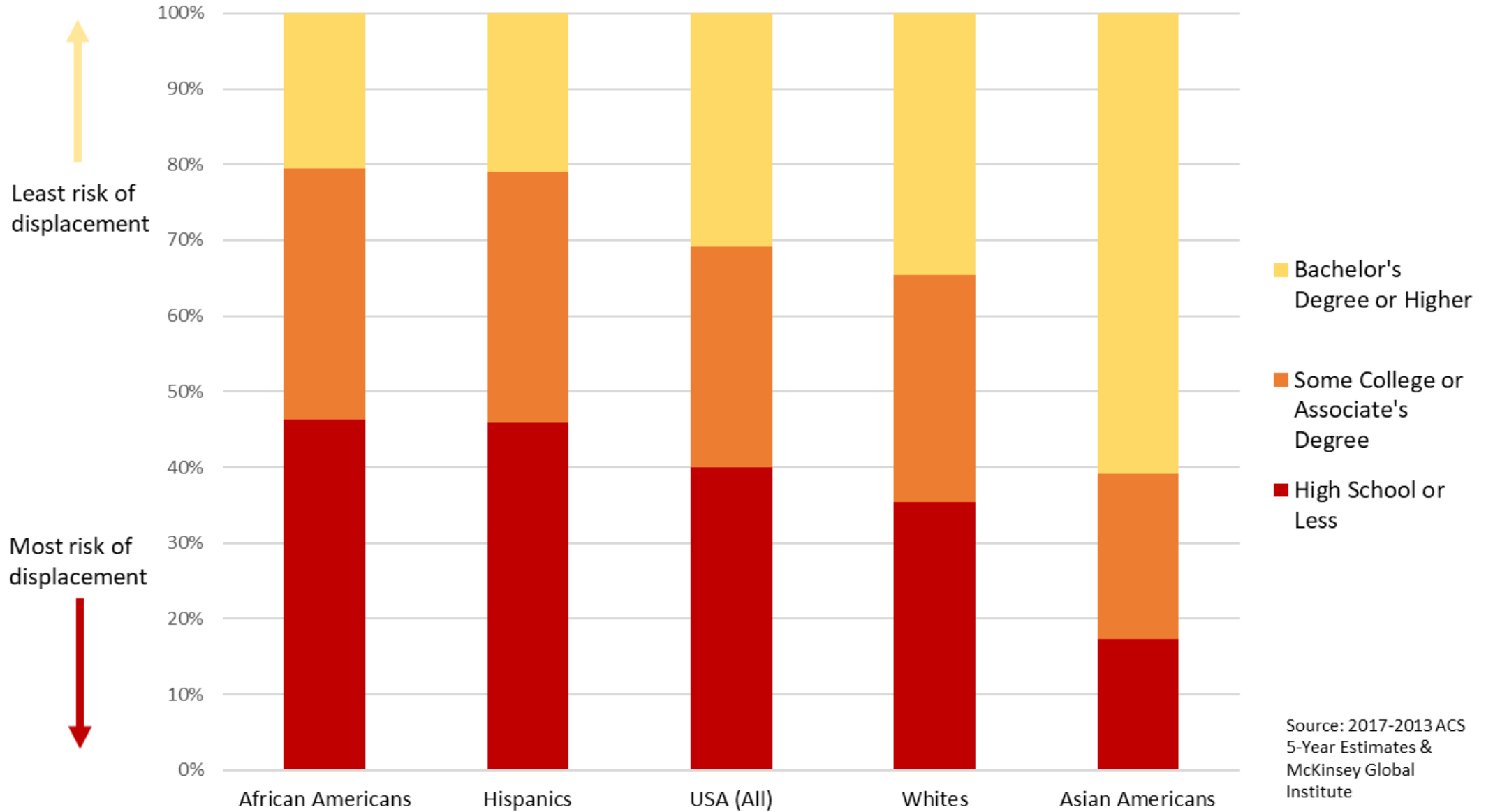

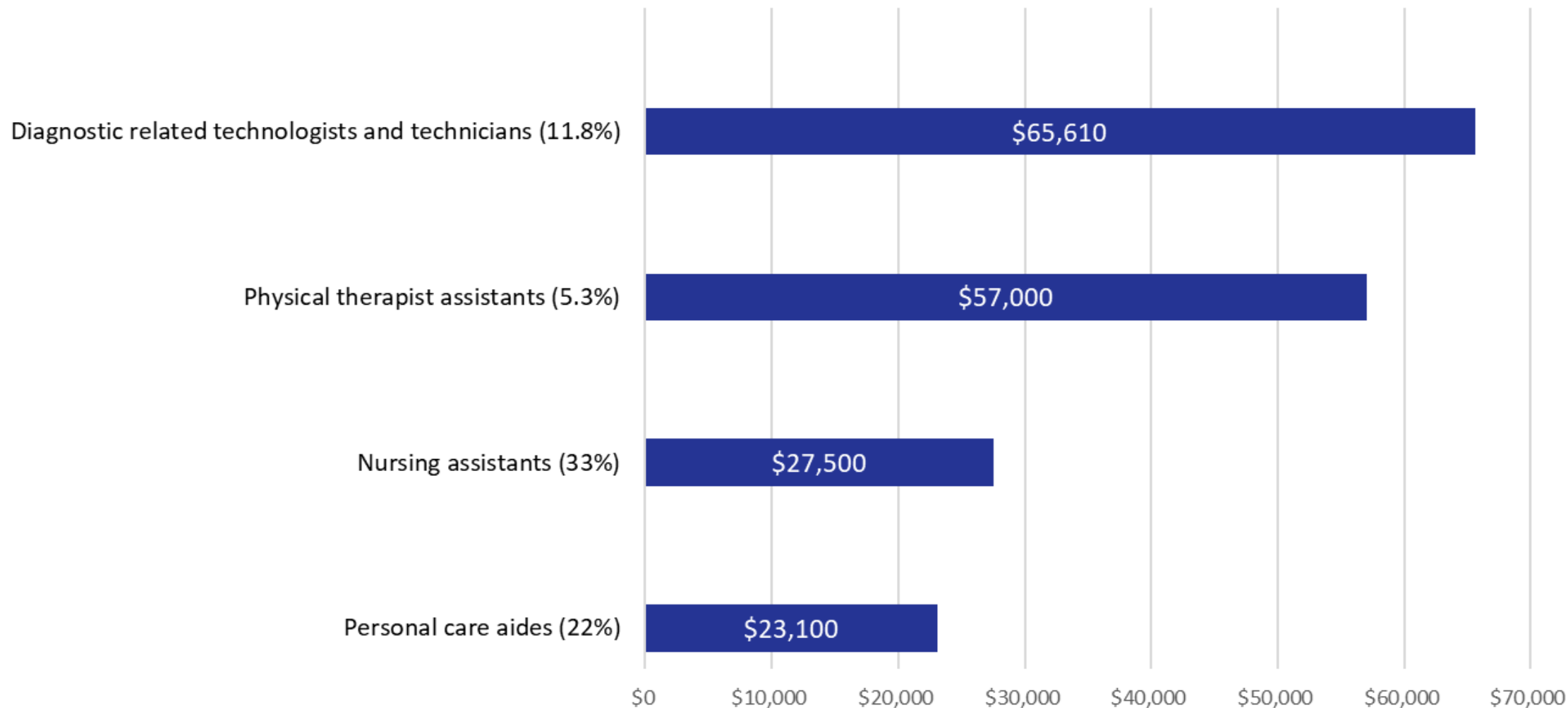
# Jobs With High Displacement Potential & Most Black Workers



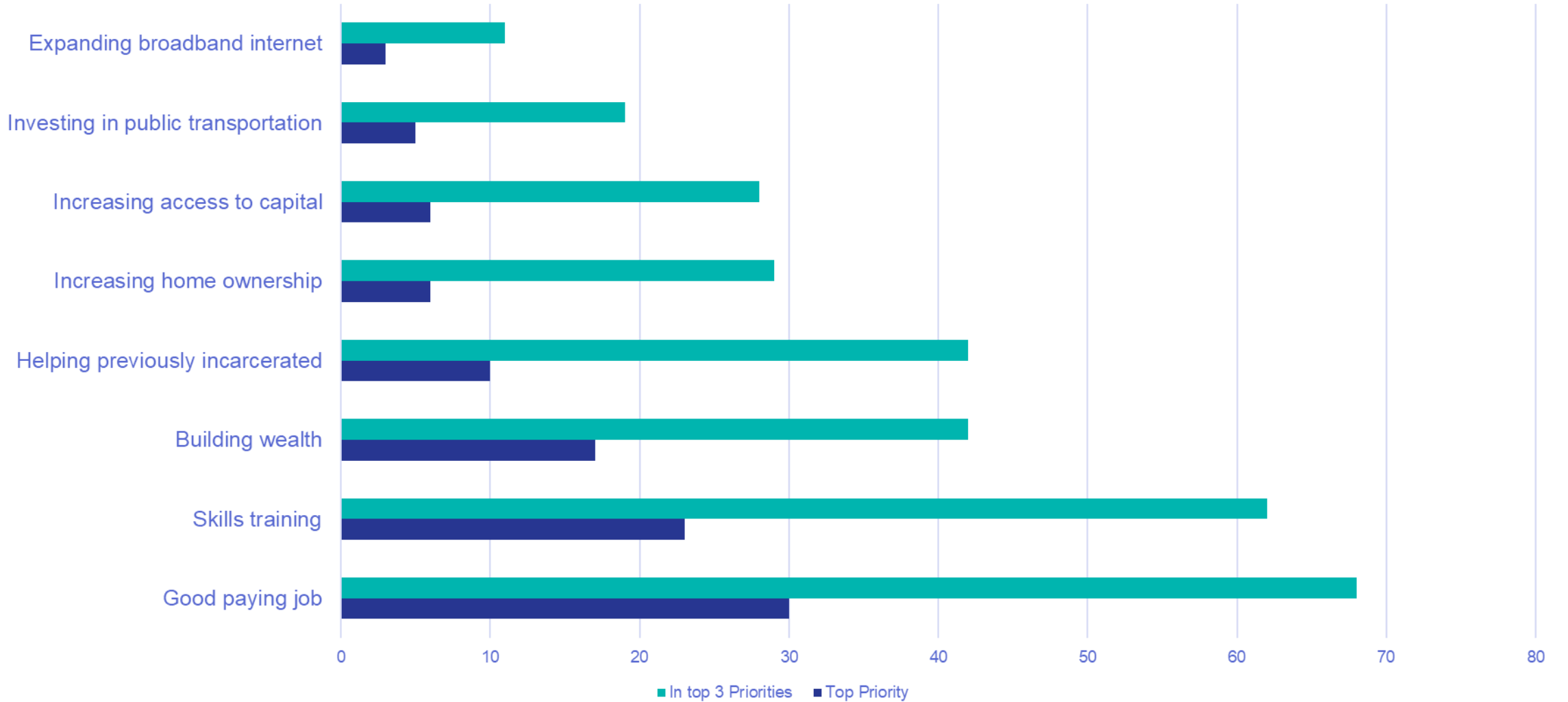
# Distribution of Educational Attainment for the Population 25 or Older



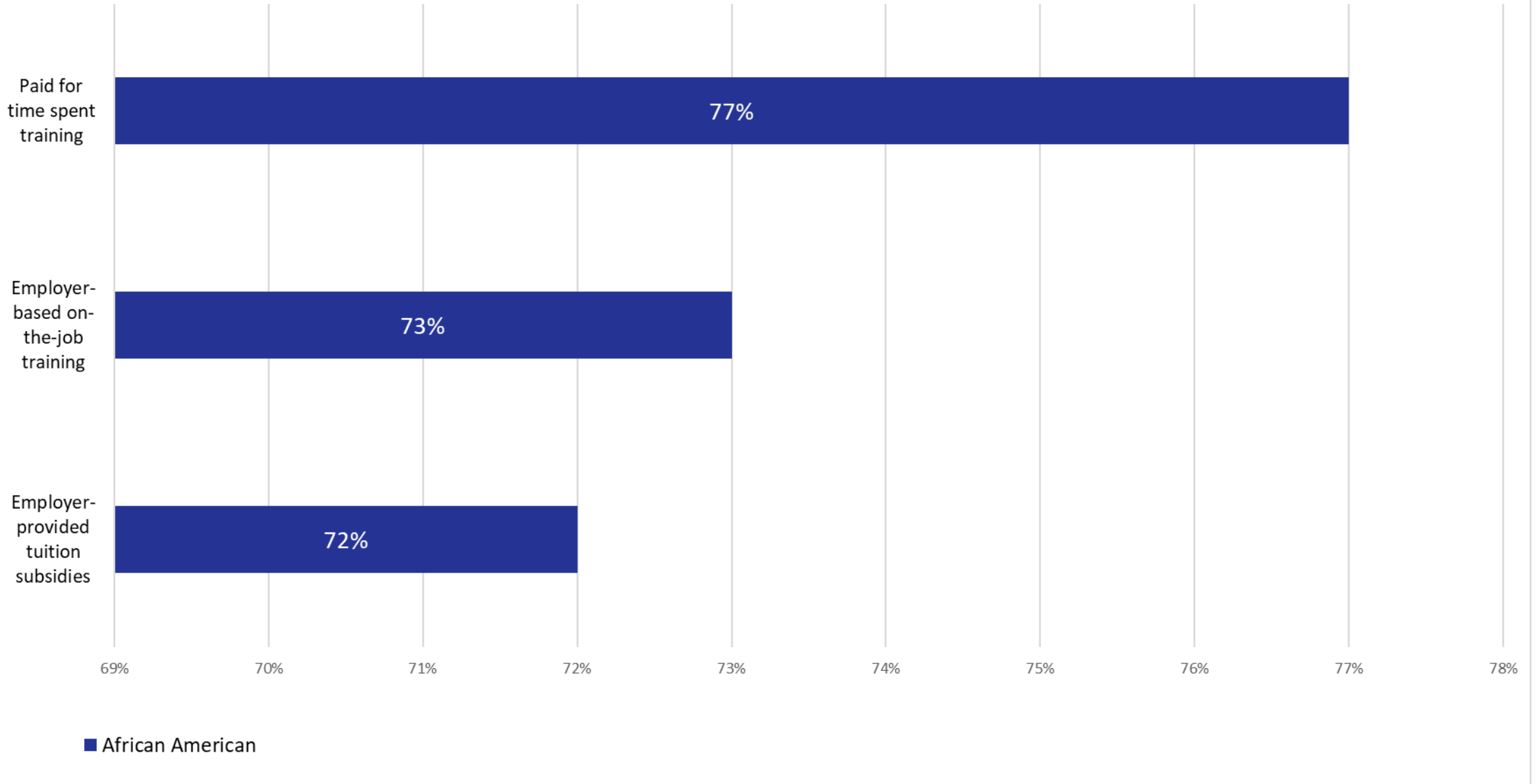
## Select High Growth Health Care Jobs that do not Require a Bachelor's (% of total workforce that is Black)



# Top Goals & Priorities for Black Workers

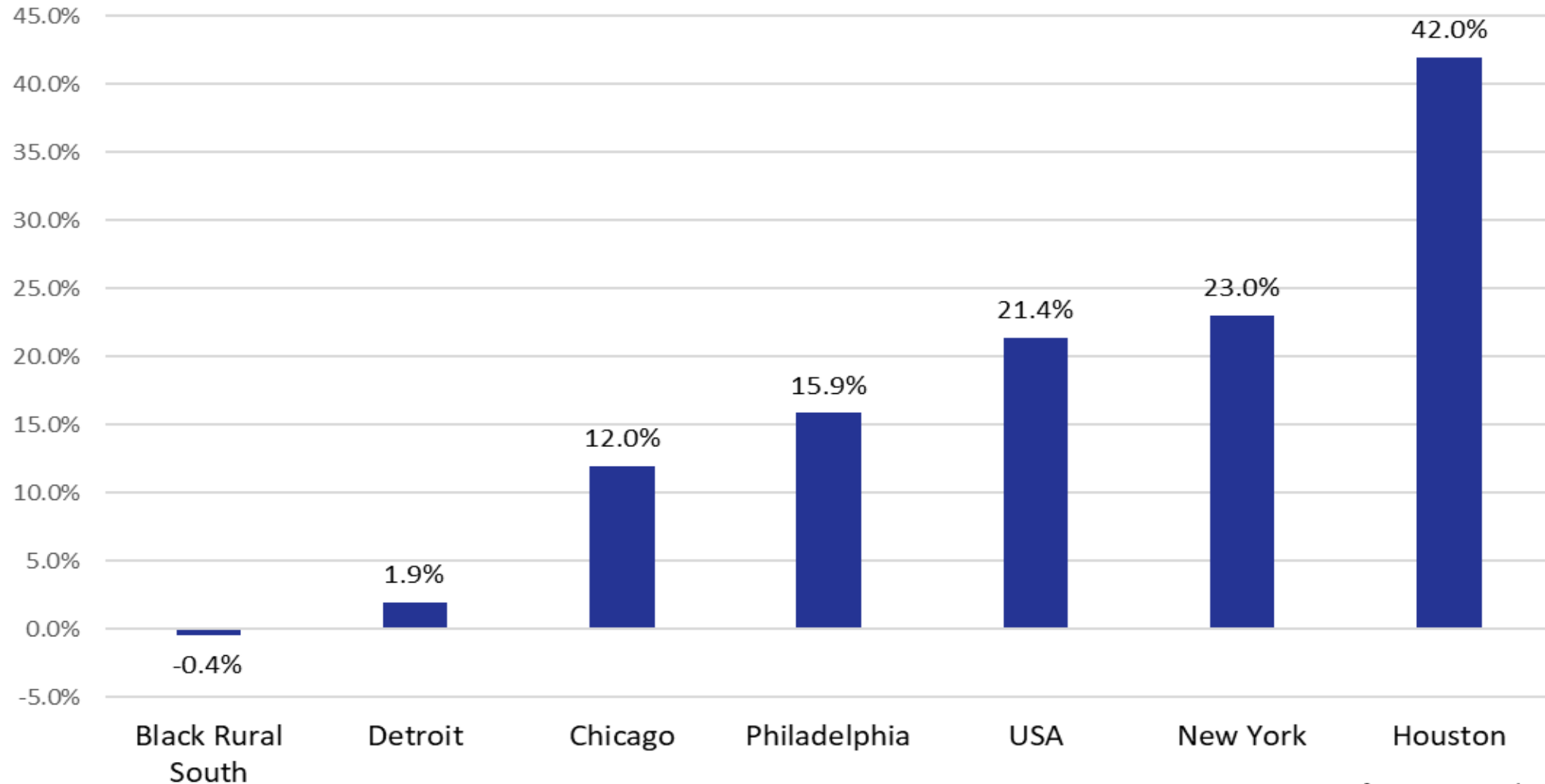


## If your current or future employer were to offer training opportunities, how interested would you be in participating in each of the following? (Very/Somewhat Interested)
