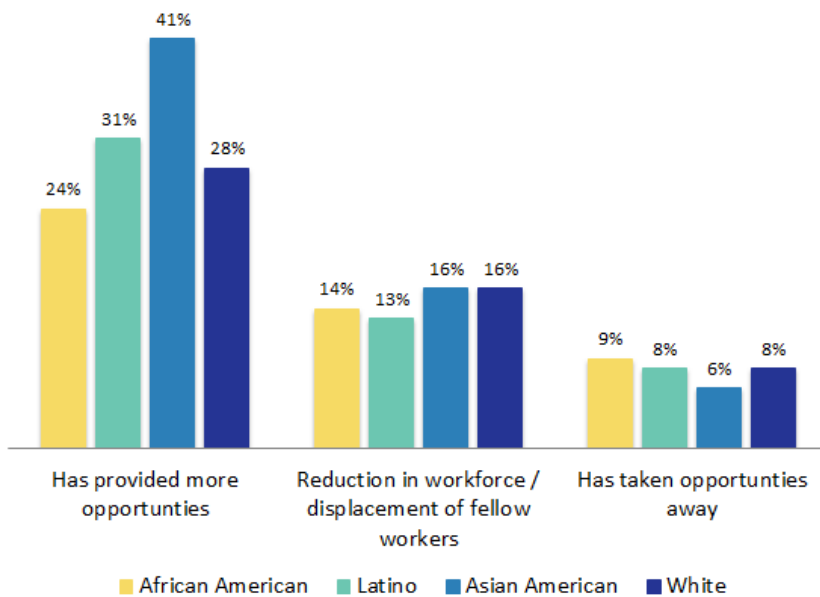


RACIAL DIFFERENCES ON THE FUTURE OF WORK: A SURVEY OF THE AMERICAN WORKFORCE



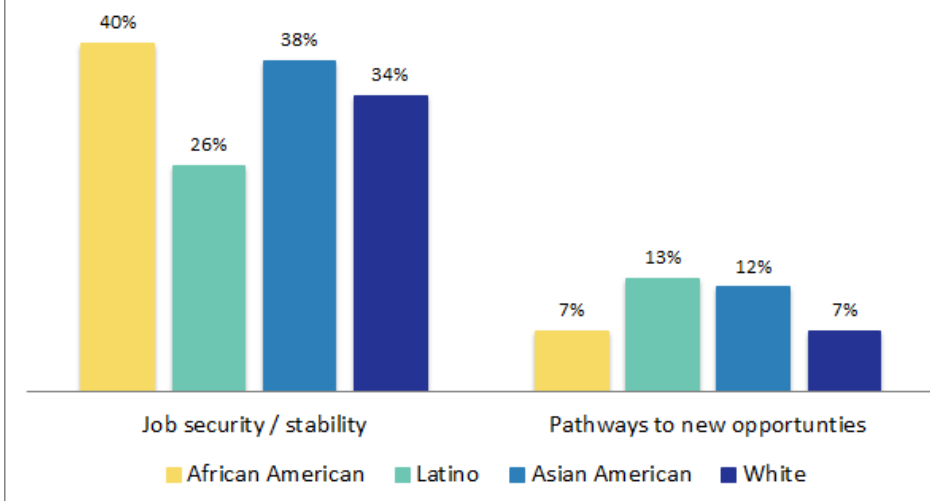
While Americans of all racial backgrounds are more likely to believe that technology provides more opportunities rather than takes opportunities away, more Americans value job security over pathways to new opportunities.

In which of the following ways, if any, has technology changed your work environment? Select all that apply.



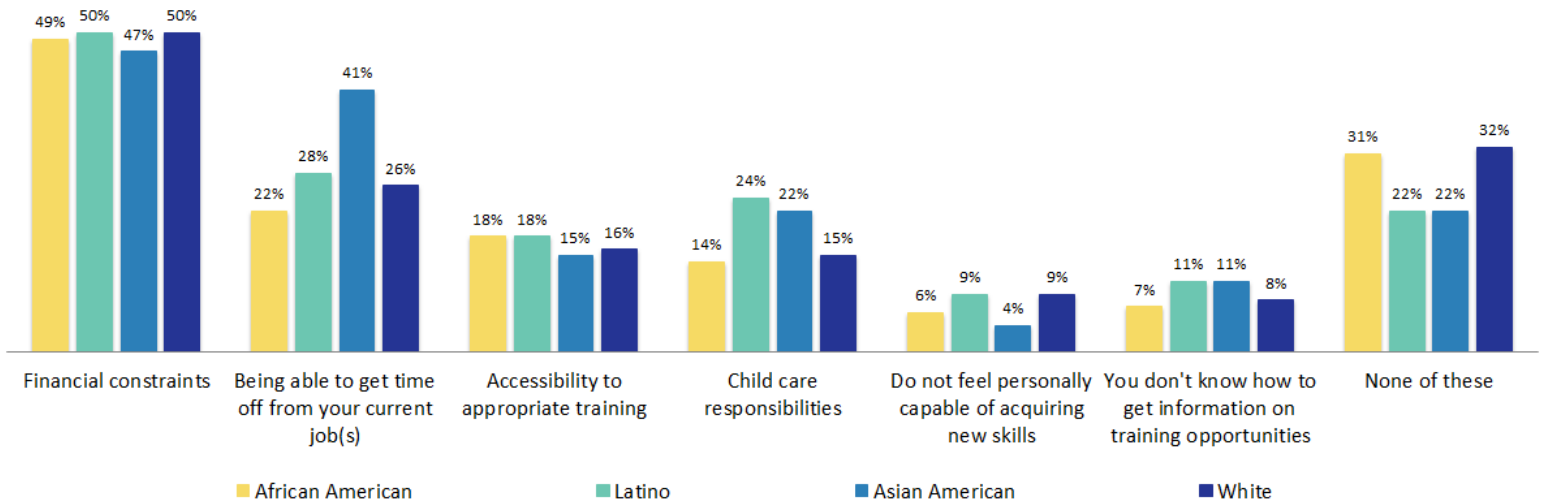
Each group of color was more interested than Whites in obtaining education or training from an in-person college degree program, community college, online college or education platform, or a GED program.

Importance of benefits offered by employer (Most Important)

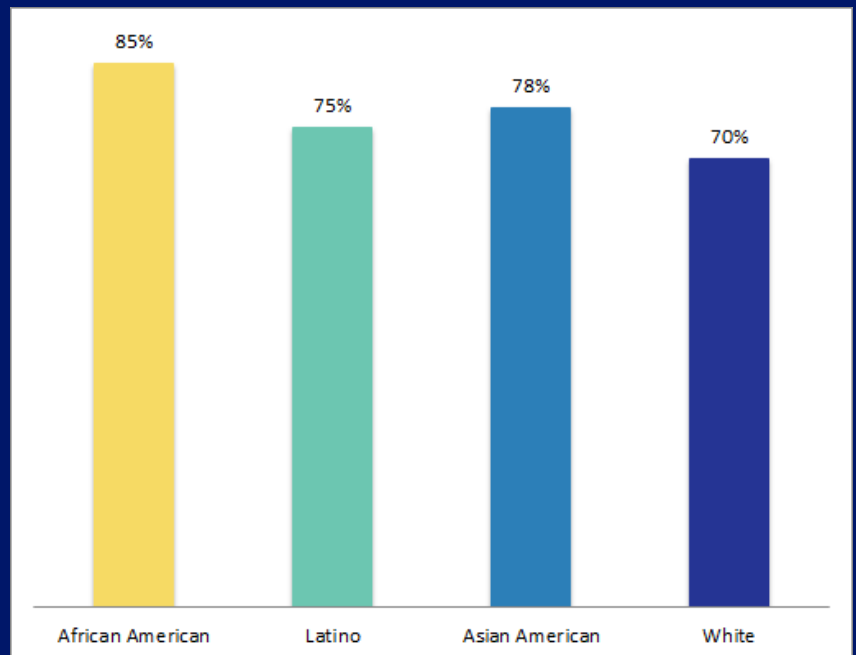


For Americans of all racial backgrounds, financial constraints were the most significant barrier to getting additional training.
